

Using the LCA Website to Find Out If Your Swimmers Qualifies.....

To find out if your swimmer's best time meets the time standard for a championship meet:

1. Log into the Web site, and then click My Meet Results on the left.
2. Click the "Member" list arrow, and then click the swimmer's name, if necessary.
3. Click the "Top Times" list arrow, and then click Top 1. (Top 1 shows your swimmer's best time for each event; if you want to see all of your swimmer's times in an event, set this to ALL.)
4. Click the "Standard" list arrow (it is green), and then click the championship meet that you are interested in.
5. Click the "Search" button.

The results will be color coded. If the results are in green, your swimmer has qualified in that event. If the results are in brown, your swimmer has not yet qualified. The amount of time that your swimmer needs to drop to meet the qualifying time will be noted in the brown box below their result time.

If you set the "Top Times" setting to Top 1, you will see your swimmer's best time for an event, without regard to course. If your swimmer's best time for an event is in long course meters, for example, you will see that time listed. To see your swimmer's events in one course or the other, click the Course list arrow, and then click SCY for short course yards or LCM or long course meters. Click the Search button to display your swimmer's best times. To return to the list of best times, without regard to course, click the Course list arrow, click ALL, and then click the Search button again.

NOTE: For Sectionals, the Bonus time standard is listed (easier), not the qualifying time standard.

To view a list of the time standards, you can either click "View Standard" next to the green box or click the Team Information tab (on top) and click Time Standards.
